OFFICE ORDER NO. 33449 //Dt 31.10.18 //
SM-1-18-IV:

In exercise of power conferred under Section 5(6) of the O.E. Act, 1969 as amended up to 1994 the committee constituted to Govt. Notification No.15641/HE., dated 01.05.04 after careful consideration, Govt. have been pleased to grant permission to open BBA & BSW Course in 60 seats each in favour of Dhenkanal Academy of Management and Technology for the academic session 2018-19 in Self Financing mode.

The above permission is subject to fulfillment of the following terms and conditions.

- (a) The State Govt. shall not bear any financial liability at any point of time or the agency or the G.B. shall claim grant-in-aid from the State Government. The institution shall be self-financing institution imparting technical and professional education without commercialization or profit motive.
- (b) Land Measuring Ac.5.00 (if the institution is located in Rural area) and Ac. 2.00 (if the institution is located in Urban area) is to be acquired in the name of the college in a compact patch with a valid title within first two years. On the said land, the building is to be constructed with progress of 25%, 50%, 75% & 100% from 4th year onwards respectively.
- (c) For colleges like course offering B. Sc. (Ag.) and Law courses must fulfill conditions enumerated in India Council for Agriculture & Research, New Delhi / Bar council of India, New Delhi.
- (d) Fire proof building holding at least three class rooms and one each Laboratories, Library teachers common room, Ladies Common room, Boys common room and office room for the intake of 30 students has to be constructed on its own land.
- (e) Faculty member- each faculty should have the following staffing pattern.

Teaching staff for each course with 30 students.

- (a) Reader - One
- (b) Lecturer - Two
- (c) Lab. Technician - Two (for BCA) one (for BBA & Other courses)

QUALIFICATIONS

BCA (Teacher) MCA or B. Engg. With Comp. Science or Electronics

BBA (Teacher) MBA or M. Comm and MCA (one)

Other Courses – Master's Degree in respective subjects.

Lab. Technical: PGDCA from recognized University or Diploma in Engg. Comp. Science or Electronics.

- (f) Institution must admit candidates selected through a common entrance test for BCA courses. Candidates in other courses shall be admitted on merit basis.
- (g) Institution must accept the fee structure prescribed by the Govt. of Orissa for admission of students. Fee structure: Rs.10,000/- per year for BCA course. However other charges if any, should not exceed Rs.5000/- per year.
- (h) Equipments:- For students minimum no. of Computers should 15 work stations & two servers (ii) Library books per paper the institution should have 20 reference Books and 30 Text Books.
- (i) The Educational Agency must recruit faculty & set the Laboratory before admitting students.
- (j) Institutions offering other courses must possess separate facilities as regards to land, building, library equipments etc. for courses as per provision of O.E. Act and rules made there-under.

- should be duly pledged to the Registrar of concerned University.
- (l) Proposal for constitution of the G.B. of the college as per provision of O.E. (Establishment, Recognition and management of Private Colleges, Rules, 1991 and Amendment Rules, 2001 should be submitted for approval of the Director, Higher Education, Odisha within two years.
 - (m) The Educational Agency shall pledge an amount of balance Rs. 10.00 lakh in 2nd installment before prescribed authority within a period of six months from the date of grant of permission failing which the Education Agency shall not be permitted to admit students.
 - (n) The Secretary of the G.B. should furnish an undertaking from an Executive Magistrate in form of an affidavit that they will not claim any financial assistance or GIA from State Govt. in future.
 - (o) Further, E.A. shall contribute non-refundable fees of Rs. 2.00 (two lakh) in shape of chalan towards loan stipend funds for poor and meritorious students by providing loan, if not deposited earlier.
 - (p) Necessary application for recognition under Section 6(1) of the O.E. Act, 1969 shall be made in duplicate in form No. II with requisite Treasury Chalan in prescribed manner with an affidavit attesting the fact that all information & particulars furnished there with are true and correct to the best of the knowledge of the deponent and an undertaking required under Sec.6 (a) of the O.E. Act, 1969 should be furnished with the application.
 - (q) In case, the Educational Agency fails to run the institute / college with aforesaid course and proposes for its closure and Govt. accords necessary permission for its closure, 50% of the pledge money of the concerned college / Institute will be forfeited with immediate effect.
